The company is actively supporting personnel departures from high-risk areas resulting from the Israel-Iran conflict, as regional security conditions continue to deteriorate.

Immediate Evacuation Support Available

With escalating regional conflicts affecting commercial flight operations and border security across Middle East, Sicuro Group has deployed specialized evacuation assets to support immediate extraction requirements with the first successful departure on 17 June 2025 for a global argichemical company.

Sicuro Group's Evacuation services include:

- **Alternative route planning** via neighboring countries when primary corridors become unavailable
